**Automotive Technology**

**Business Accounting**

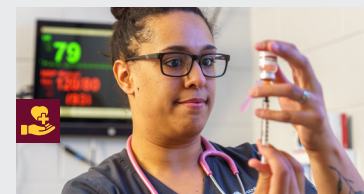
# Short-Term Healthcare Trainings



**Emergency Medical Sciences**  
Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) provide care in the pre-hospital setting. The program provides opportunities to gain information and skills necessary for certification and practice as an EMT.



**Certified Nurse Aide**  
CNAs work under a licensed nurse in adult care homes, hospitals, clinics, and other environments where residents/patients benefit from assistance with activities of daily living.



**Certified Medication Aide**  
Certified Medication Aide works under the supervision of a licensed nurse in an adult care home to administer prescribed medications and selected therapies.



**Phlebotomy**  
Phlebotomists are responsible for collecting blood, urine, and other samples, packaging them and preparing them to be sent for analysis as requested by medical personnel.



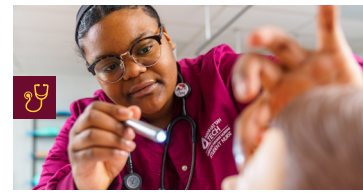
**Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning**  
Become a skilled technician by learning to install, service and repair refrigeration and air conditioning systems in commercial and residential settings.



**Industrial Maintenance Technology**  
Instruction of theory as well as hands on application of skills required for advanced manufacturing, industrial automation, and mechanical troubleshooting.



**Medical Laboratory Technology**  
Prepare and analyze specimens using body fluids and cells. Use microscopes and other sophisticated laboratory equipment and computerized instruments to test and analyze results.



**Nursing - Associate Degree**  
Prepare to become a Registered Nurse. Designed specifically for students who have an LPN, this program presents the coursework students need in order to prepare them for the licensing exam.



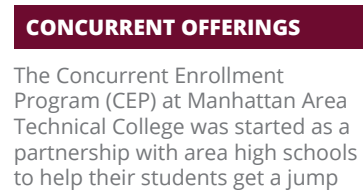
**Nursing - Practical**
