

BOOKS

Access to required textbooks and digital course materials is provided through Cengage Unlimited at a cost of \$100 per semester. This fee is included in your total tuition and fees, so there's no need to purchase most textbooks separately. Materials are available digitally and can be accessed once you're enrolled in your courses.

RAVE EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

RAVE notifies students of critical messages like weather delays and emergencies. All students will be automatically enrolled in the Alert system.

SAFE DEFEND

Manhattan Tech has partnered with SafeDefend™, a comprehensive system designed to prepare, notify, and safeguard individuals in the event of active shooter or other violent scenarios.

There are specific deadlines for withdrawing from each course; students should refer to the Drop/ Withdrawal calendar for their course dates.

DROP/WITHDRAWAL PERIOD

Refund and drop/withdrawal deadlines for classes with non-standard dates may differ. These important dates are outlined in the drop/withdrawal calendar, which specifies the deadlines for 100% and 50% refunds, as well as the last day to withdraw.

To meet these deadlines, students must submit a Drop or Withdrawal form before the specified dates.



If you have set up direct deposit in MATCOnline, any credit balances are deposited directly into your bank account. If not, the Business Office mails overage checks to your permanent home address on record.

WORK-STUDY

Student employment (work-study) is an excellent opportunity for you to get real workplace experience while also earning money to help with the costs associated with going to college. Unlike other types of financial aid, work-study earnings are distributed in a paycheck, based on hours worked, just like a normal job. The current pay rate is \$10 per hour.

30 DAY DELAY POLICY

Financial aid disbursement typically begins about 30 days after classes start, with refunds processed shortly thereafter. This timeline starts on the first day of the semester. Students should plan accordingly for living expenses during this period. To help with book costs, eligible students can use book vouchers during the first week of the semester.

SET-UP DIRECT DEPOSIT


Students are encouraged to set up direct deposit to receive financial aid refunds and other payments more efficiently. Direct deposit is the fastest and most secure method for receiving funds, eliminating the need to wait for paper checks.

TO KEEP YOUR REGISTRATION FROM POTENTIALLY BEING CANCELLED:

Complete one of the following prior to the financial obligation deadline:

- » Pay tuition in full
- » Set-up a payment plan manhattantech.edu/paymentplans
- » Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
- » Provide a third-party payment authorization to the Student Account Specialist (employer, Military Benefits, etc.)



IMPORTANT:

If you are not enrolled in a payment plan and do not have a FAFSA on file, you must have a down payment in place by Fall: August 29th, 2025
Spring: January 31st, 2026 or your registration might be cancelled.


A \$25 per month late fee will be applied for any unpaid balances. If your registration is cancelled due to non-payment you may not be able to get back into full courses.
