

Phlebotomy Course

This course introduces the principles and practices of phlebotomy. Participants will learn terminology and procedures for infection control and safety while developing skills in specimen collection and equipment use. **The course alone does not grant national certification in phlebotomy**. However, instruction is aligned with national standards and may fulfill <u>partial</u> requirements toward certification through the American Society of Clinical Pathology (ASCP). *

The course requires independent, online work. <u>Lecture material is taught ONLINE and phlebotomy skills are taught in mandatory face-to-face labs.</u> Students must be able to use a computer to access and use course materials, and to submit course assignments.

Class enrollment will close once 12 students are enrolled.

Required for Enrollment:

- Documentation of immunizations or a titer of immunity for:
 - MMR (2), Chicken Pox/Varicella (2), Hepatitis B (3). Tetanus (1 immunization within last 10 years);
- Report of negative TB skin test completed within the last year (or TB chest x-ray, blood test report)
- Evidence of current Influenza Vaccination completed for the current influenza season.
