NEW SEMESTER, NEW RESOURCES

This year the TLC is introducing several new academic resources available to both students and faculty. We have also consolidated these resources for you within our newly redesigned website. All of the resources introduced here are available on our new [Academic Resources & Databases](#) page. This article is a quick introduction to these new and some existing resources.

1. Grammarly - Grammarly is a program that checks for grammatical errors, provides vocabulary enhancement suggestions, gives citation suggestions, and has a built-in plagiarism checker. All Manhattan Tech students enrolled in a communications course have access to

Grammarly. Student access will be valid only for the time you are an active student. Any faculty or staff member of Manhattan Tech is also welcome to full access of Grammarly. For more information, or to get access, contact the TLC.

2. Bookshare - Bookshare is a large online library for people with visual or print disabilities. They have an extensive collection of textbooks available for use on computers, Chromebooks, tablets, smartphones, assistive technology devices, and more. You must qualify through Student Retention to use this resource. For more information, contact the TLC.

3. Databases & Catalog - The Manhattan Tech research databases and online catalog have been updated and redesigned. We hope they are more user friendly.

The Teaching & Learning Center offers several options for students to conduct research. These options include program-specific and general education research databases. Some of these are available on-campus only.

CANVAS IS HERE!

Manhattan Tech's new LMS is here! As of the fall 2018 Semester, Canvas is the official learning management system on campus. All courses are being taught in Canvas.

Yes, MATConline is still around. However, it will no longer be used for course delivery.

Students, you **WILL NOT** have access to courses through MATConline. Only Canvas will be used for all course material and assignment access.
